Triple P is a free parenting program that doesn't tell you how to be a parent. It's more like a toolbox of ideas - you choose the strategies you need and the way you want to use them. Triple P has been shown to improve parents' wellbeing and parenting skills, and reduce problem behaviours at home.

The Seminar Series

Three seminars offer simple and practical strategies to help you confidently manage your children's behaviour, prevent problems developing, and to build strong, healthy relationships. It is for **every** parent who has a child between 2 and 12 years old.
